Dear iCARE Partners, Supporters, and Volunteers,

The Great Shape! Inc. iCARE program has completed its first mission for the people of Antigua. It was an overwhelming success! We served in St. John's at Grace Baptist Church. We were met by long lines each morning and all day as patients arrived as early as 4 AM.

The population of the island is estimated at ~97,000, of which we served 2,126. This is almost 2.2% of the country in 5 days of our free eye care clinic. Everyone who needed prescription glasses will receive them in a few months after we fabricate them in the US.

Our RNs performed over 1000 glucose and blood pressure screenings. Of those screened, approximately 50% of patients had blood pressures and/or glucose levels outside of healthy parameters, with 21% showing life threatening levels (blood pressure > 180/110 and/or blood glucose greater > 400mg/dL). Patients with these excessive levels were referred to their local hospital or clinic for immediate care. Healthy lifestyle counseling, disease process education, and instruction on medication compliance were also provided based on Antigua Ministry of Health guidelines for the management of hypertension and diabetes. Of note are the several previously unknown cases of diabetes that were undiagnosed. This is life-saving information!



## The metrics for iCARE 2019 Antigua are as follows:

Clinic Site: Grace Baptist Church – St. John's – 8/26/2019 to 8/30/2019

- 26 volunteers includes 5 optometrists, 3 RNs, and 3 opticians
- 2126 vision exams in clinic
- over 1000 nurse visits with blood pressure and/or blood sugar screenings
- almost 16.7% of total patients served require new prescription (test) glasses
  - o distributed ~35 pairs of prescription glasses
  - o making 320 pairs of custom prescription glasses in the US to be delivered asap
- distributed ~1600 pairs of reading glasses
- distributed ~2300 pairs of sunglasses
- 89 pathology referrals to the local hospital MSJMC
- 214 pathology diagnosis, consisting of:
  - o 95 glaucoma
  - o 44 cataracts
  - o 12 pterygium
  - o 7 macular degeneration
  - o 7 ocular hypertension
  - o 40 miscellaneous, includes keratoconus, corneal abrasion, chalazion, CSME, PCO, solar retinopathy, maculopathy, optic neuropathy, mascular edema, blindness, pre-retinal membrane, retinitis pigmentosa, symblepharon, ocular myasthenia, entropion, bacterial conjunctivitis, eyelid cysts, corneal ulcer, strabismus, and band keratopathy
  - o Appropriate on-hand medications were dispensed.
- ~US\$347,087 value in goods and services









Since our inception 11 years ago, iCARE has conducted 21 weeks of clinics and 5 weeks of cataract surgery – providing the following critical services and goods free of cost to the beautiful people of Jamaica, Antigua, and Turks & Caicos, at an estimated value of over US\$10.78 million:

- ~40,056 eye exams (includes 176 cataract surgeries, 255 SLT laser surgeries, and 33 diabetic retinopathy PRP laser surgeries)
- ~83,675 pairs of glasses (includes prescription, reading, custom, and sunglasses)

Please note that all of these numbers will increase for 2019, as we still have two weeks of clinic and one week of surgery to complete this year in Jamaica during October and November.



















The following graphs illustrate our patient & glasses totals and the value of goods & services, to date, over the 11 years of the program:
