Dear iCARE Partners, Supporters, and Volunteers,

The Great Shape! Inc. iCARE program has completed its inaugural mission for the people of Barbados. Our free eye care clinic, held from August 8 to 11, 2022 was wildly successful. We continue to see greater need since pandemic times because of lack of access and financing due to shutdowns. We served in the parish of Christ Church in the beautiful Sandals Royal Barbados Ballroom, located on Maxwell Coast Road, which was generously made accessible to the general public.

From the first day of clinic the patient turnout was impressive. Bajans queued from the early morning hours. Our team of 33 volunteers served with love, grace, and diligence to ensure as many as possible were treated each day to our services of full eye exams, glasses, medications, and hypertension/diabetes screening. The clinic days were long.

The population of Barbados is estimated at ~288,000, of which we served 1,833. We distributed 2,151 sunglasses, 1,295 reading glasses, and 139 premade prescription glasses. Custom prescription glasses will be manufactured in the U.S. for the 346 we could not accommodate in the clinic, for a total of 485 patient prescriptions – almost 27% of our patient total. The custom glasses will be hand delivered in the next three months.

Our health evaluation team performed 985 diabetes and hypertension screenings. 56% exhibited higher than normal blood pressures with 10% showing critical, life-threatening pressures – the highest recorded at 244/156. 31% presented elevated blood sugar with 7% displaying critical, life-threatening levels – the highest recorded over 500 (greater than our meters are able to read). Abnormal patients were educated on ways to restore health and were referred to their local health care providers for immediate care.

The metrics for iCARE Barbados 2022 are as follows:

Clinic Site: Sandals Royal Barbados Ballroom, Christ Church, Barbados 8/8/2022 to 8/11/2022

- 33 volunteers
- 1.833 vision exams
- 985 health screenings for diabetes and hypertension with education
- 26.4% of total patients required prescription glasses (485 total), of which 346 will be custom made in the U.S. and returned in a few months
- distributed 1,295 reading glasses
- distributed 2,151 sunglasses
- over 300 pathology referrals to the local or private healthcare system
- over US\$120,000 retail value of medications dispensed
- ~US\$484,239 estimated total value in goods and services

Since our inception 13 years ago, iCARE has conducted 25 weeks of clinics and 5 weeks of cataract surgery – providing the following critical services and goods free of cost to the beautiful people of Jamaica, Antigua, Turks & Caicos, St. Lucia, and Barbados at an estimated value of over US\$13.53 million:

- ~47,501 eye exams and procedures (includes 217 cataract surgeries, 22 MIG surgeries, 792 SLT laser surgeries, 100 diabetic retinopathy PRP laser surgeries, and 1 laser retinopexy)
- ~97,027 glasses (includes prescription, reading, and sunglasses)







The following graph outlines the number of pathologies diagnosed in our clinic, where more than one case was discovered:










