Dear iCARE Partners, Supporters, and Volunteers,

This year we planned to conduct two weeks of eye care clinics and a week of surgery. Our first week was a great success, while our second week was preempted by powerful Hurricane Melissa. We are deeply saddened that we were unable to complete our planned service and more distraught by the damage wrought on the country we serve and love. Our hearts go out to the people of Jamaica who have lost so much, but continue to be optimistic and unyielding, showing the world their beautiful spirits, resiliency, and culture. Jamaica shall overcome and we will do what we can to support the many rebuilding efforts.

Our second week was scheduled for William Knibb Memorial Baptist Church in Falmouth, Trelawny and included cataract and MIG surgery at Cornwall Hospital in Montego Bay, St. James. We also planned to perform laser procedures for PRP and SLT.

Our free clinic was held during the week of September 29 in the hills above Lucea at the Greenland United Church in Greenland, Hanover. Our services included full eye exams, glasses (prescription, reading, sun), pathology referrals, medications, PRP (panretinal photocoagulation) laser procedures for diabetic retinopathy, and hypertension/diabetes screenings with education.

















Our health evaluation team screened patients over 45 years of age with a family history of hypertension or diabetes, who have not recently been tested or who ask for a test for any reason. Those exhibiting unhealthy levels were educated on methods to restore health and referred to their local health care provider for immediate care if needed.

In our Greenland clinic, 66% of those screened for hypertension exhibited higher than normal blood pressures, with the highest reading of 211/125 (see chart). 49.8% of those screened for diabetes exhibited higher than normal glucose levels, with the highest reading of 581 (see chart).



The metrics for iCARE 2025 Jamaica are as follows:

Clinic Site: Greenland United Church – Greenland, Hanover PRP Laser Site: Cornwall Regional Hospital – Montego Bay, St. James September 29 2025 to October 3, 2025

- 52 volunteers & 3,516 patients served
 - o 1,365 in clinic
 - o 2,116 school screenings
 - o 35 PRP patients
- 50 PRPs
- 586 health screenings for hypertension with education
- 464 health screenings for diabetes with education
- 475 pairs of prescription glasses will be dispensed. We distributed 116 in clinic and we
 will fabricate 359 custom made pairs in the U.S. to be returned in January.
 - o 34.8% of total clinic patients seen required prescription glasses
- distributed ~532 reading glasses & ~1,499 sunglasses
- over 200 medical referrals to public or private healthcare system
- ~US\$417,152 retail value of medications dispensed

The estimated total value in goods and services for iCARE Jamaica 2025 is ~US\$847,768. Including our week of service in Exuma & Nassau, Bahamas (April/May) and Kingstown & Buccament, Saint Vincent (August), iCARE 2025 served in total 7,257 patients, with total goods and services valued at ~US\$2.127 million.

Since our inception 16 years ago, iCARE has conducted 36 weeks of clinics and 8 weeks of cataract/MIG surgery – providing the following critical services and goods free of cost to the beautiful people of Jamaica, Turks & Caicos, Antigua, St. Lucia, Barbados, The Bahamas, Grenada, and St. Vincent at an estimated total value of over **US\$21.598 million**. This encompasses:

- 69,262 eye exams and procedures (includes 323 cataract surgeries, 77 MIG surgeries for glaucoma, 820 SLT laser procedures for glaucoma, 225 PRP laser procedures for diabetic retinopathy, 2 laser retinopexies for detached retina), 1 IOL reposition, and 1 ectropian.
- 135,767 glasses (includes prescription, reading, and sunglasses)













